

AY 2022 Spring Semester Donor Designated Scholarships Entry Form

- When making an application for donor designated scholarships during the Spring Semester recruitment, students need to submit this entry form after checking the boxes for the specific scholarships they wish to apply to. Students may apply to a **maximum number of five scholarship providers** regardless of whether they provide merit-based or need-based scholarships. However, for the Goldman Sachs Scholars Fund and the Alumni Association Scholarship (Faculty of Science and Technology), students should use the Application Slip rather than this Entry Form. These two scholarships do not count toward the maximum total of five scholarship providers permitted.
- In the case of an essay topic being the same for different providers when applying to more than one scholarship, it is acceptable for students to submit one essay for all of the applications concerned.
