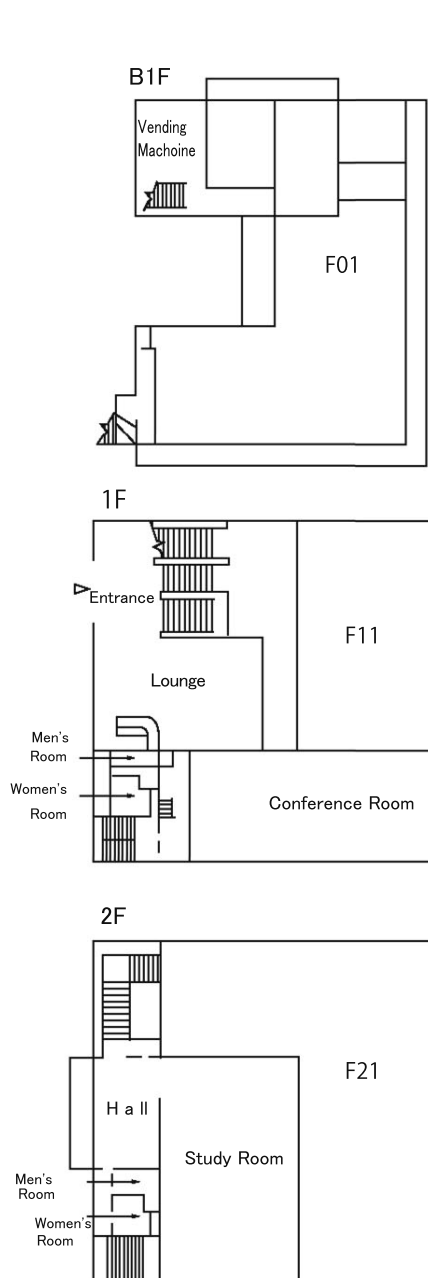

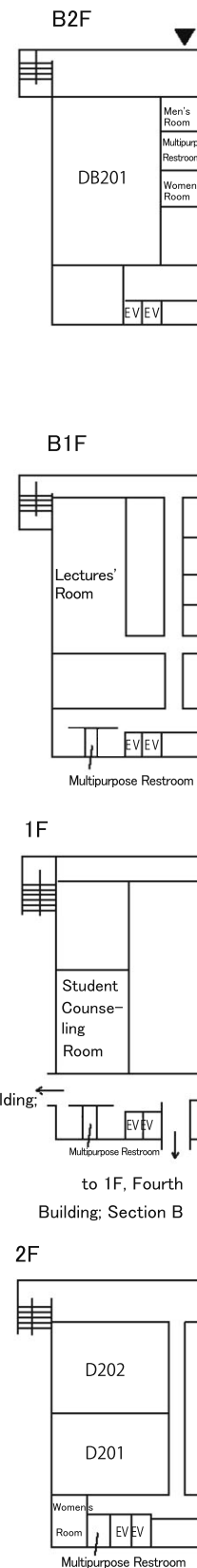
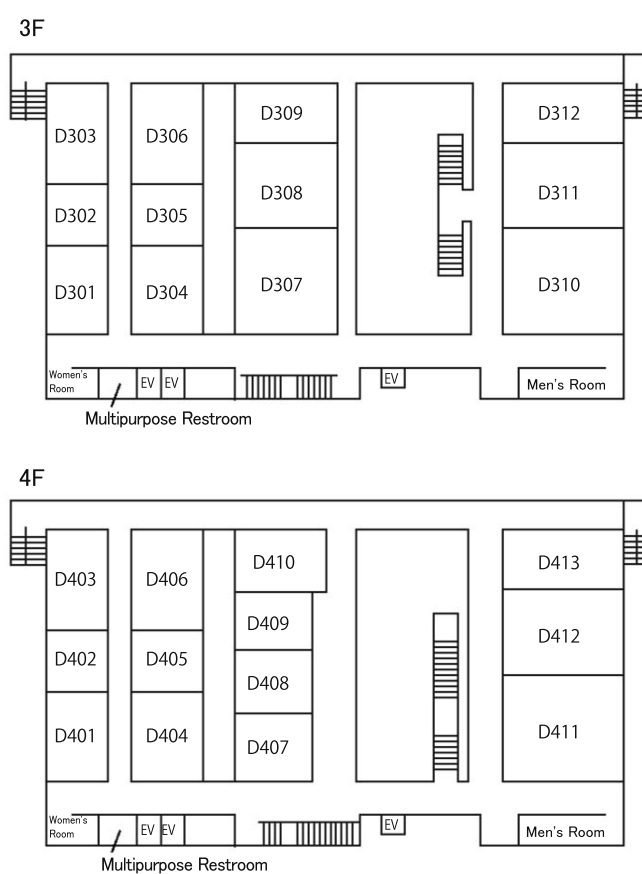
Classroom Map

【Fujiyama Memorial Hall】

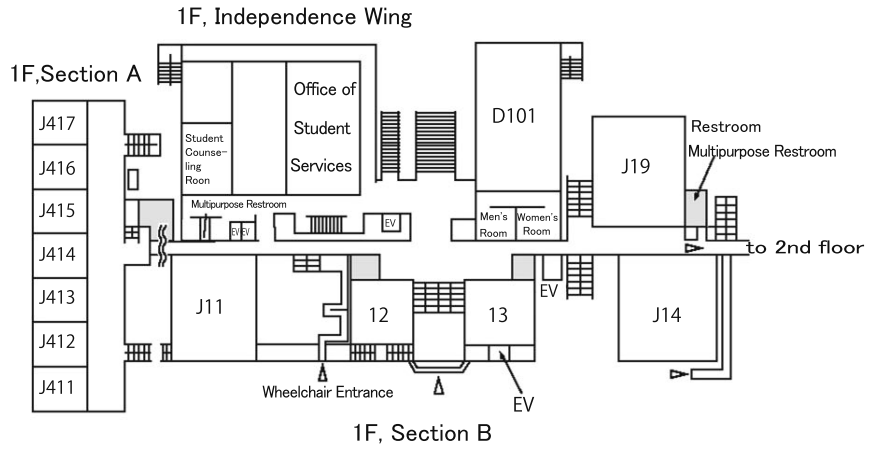
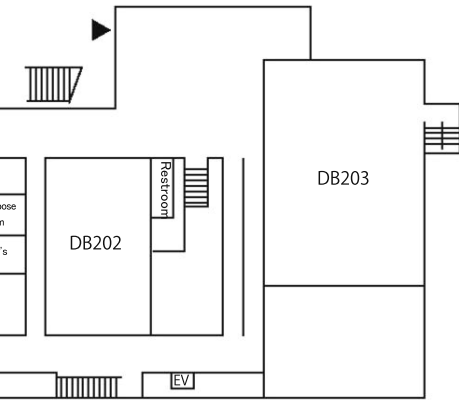

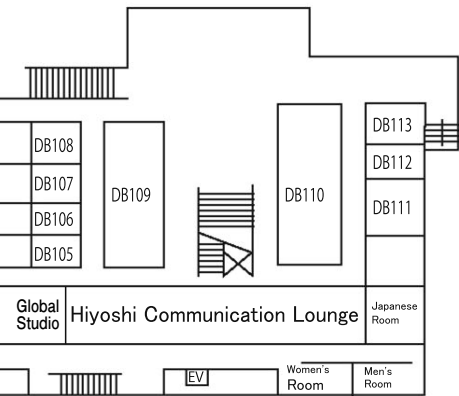
【Fourth Building Independence Wing】



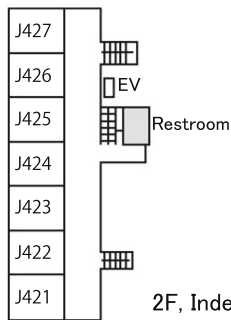
【Fourth Building General View】



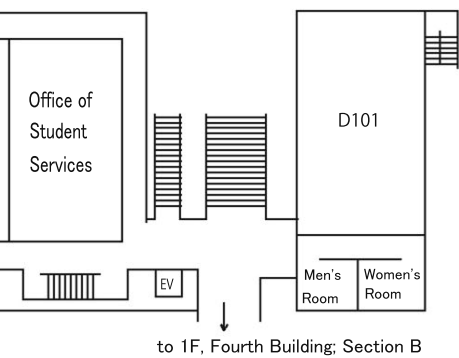
