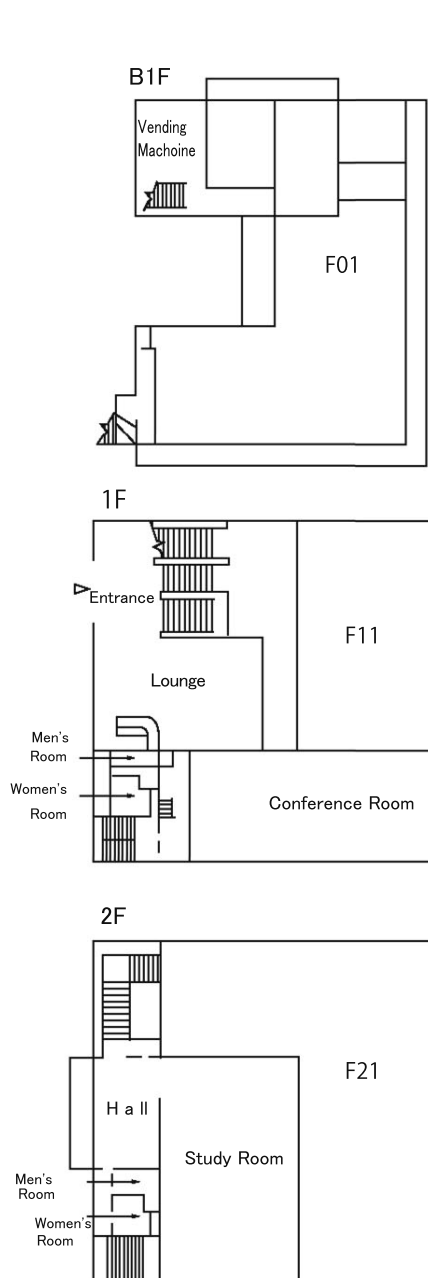

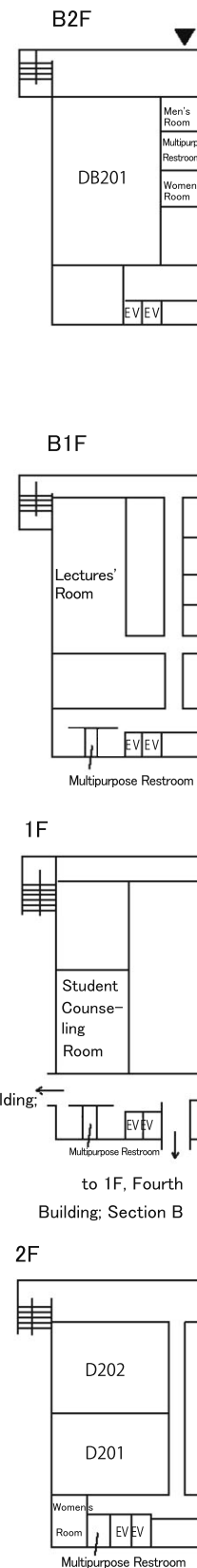
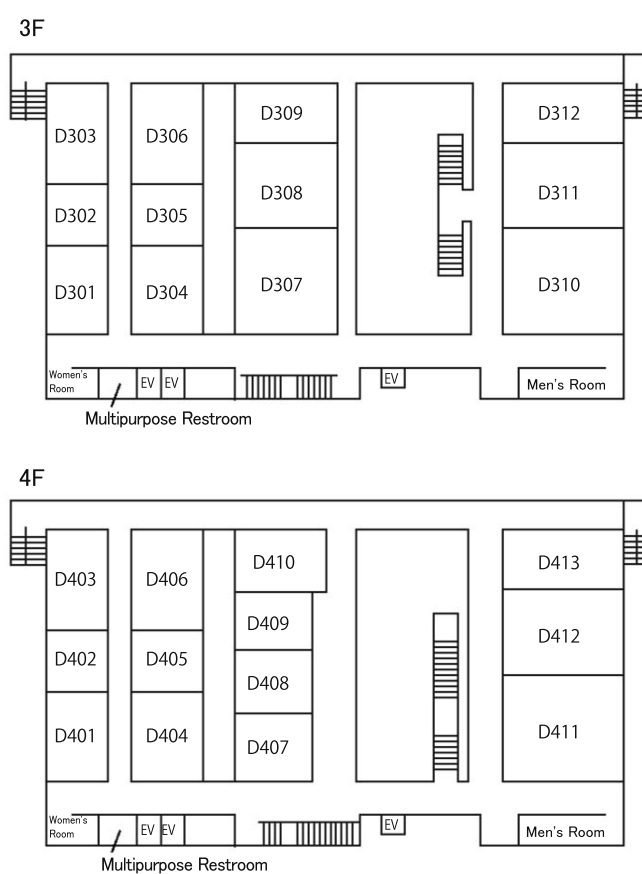
Classroom Map
