• Adjustments will be made to a course if there are a particularly large number of students registering for it. (Highly possible for the course *.)

Classroom Map

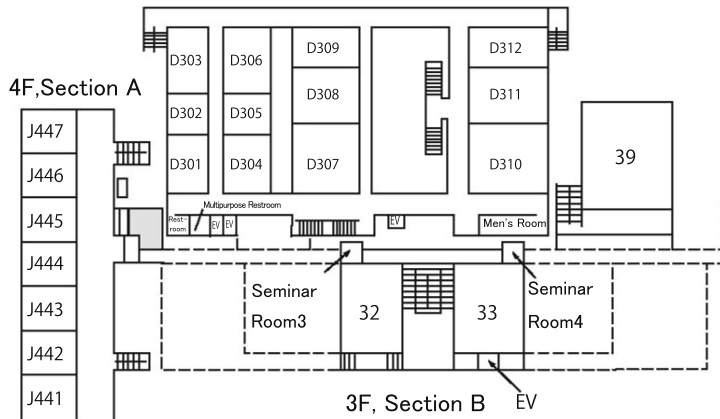
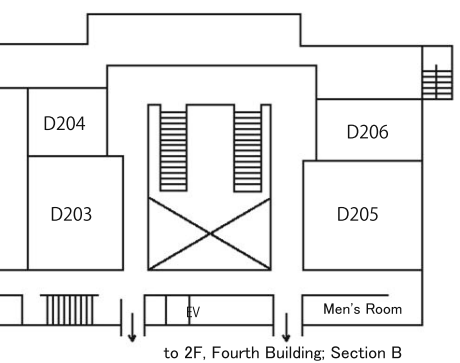
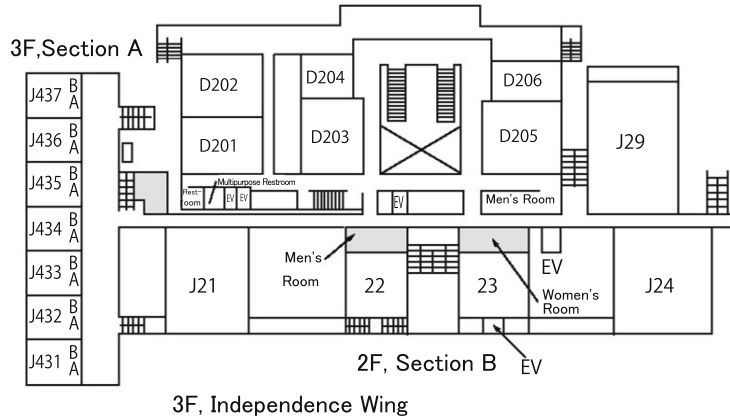
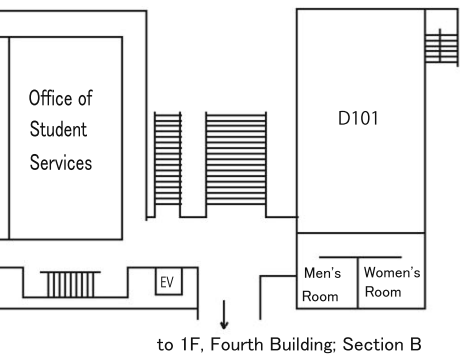
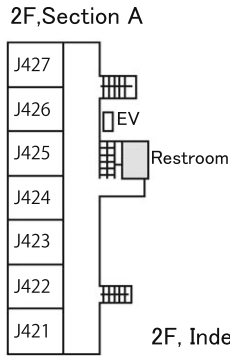
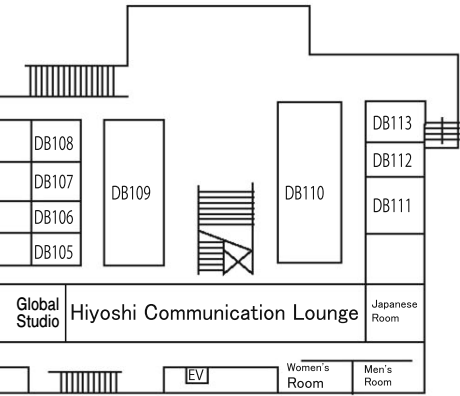
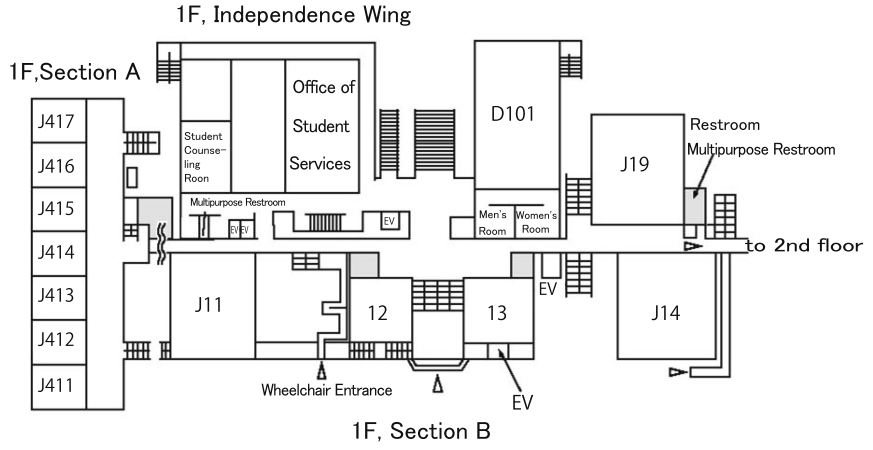
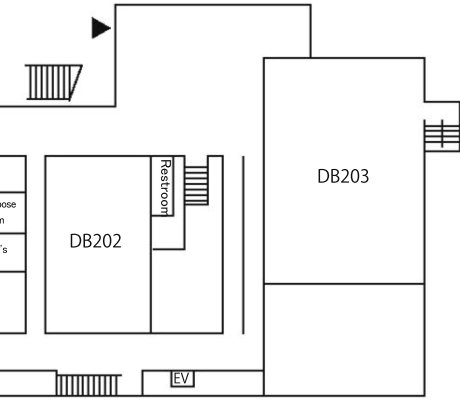

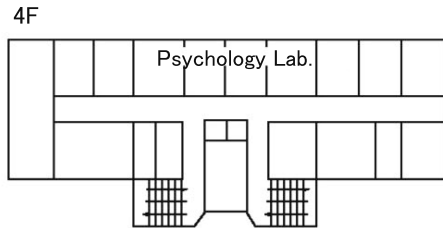
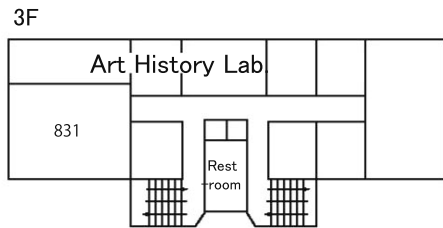
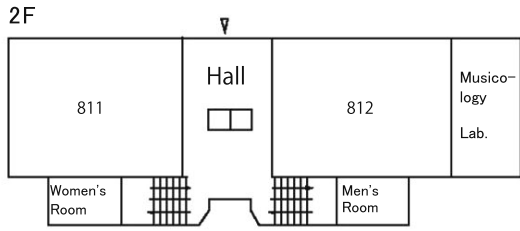
【Fourth Building Independence Wing】



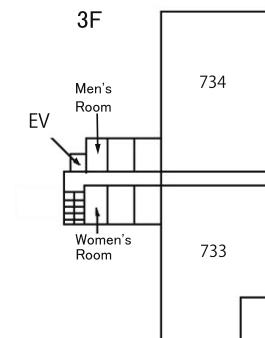
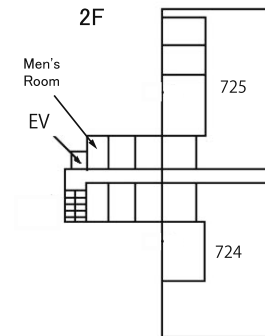
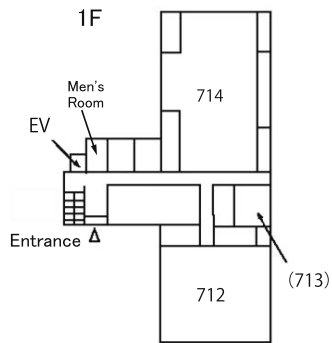
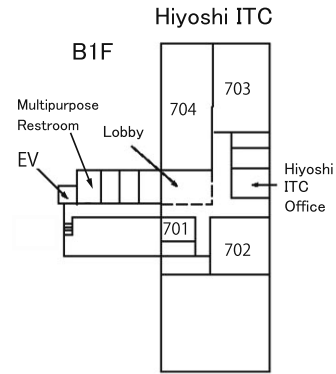
【Fourth Building General View】



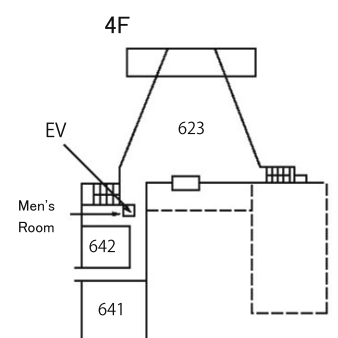
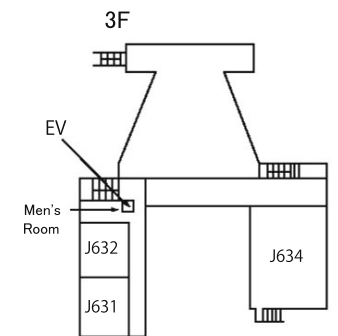
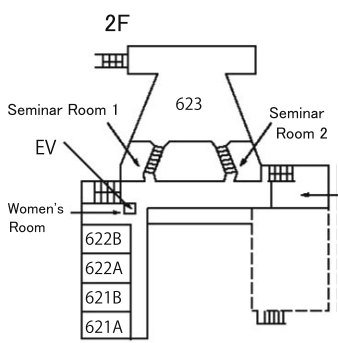
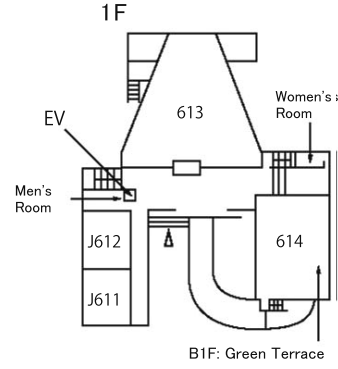

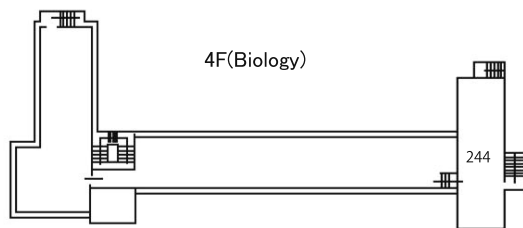
