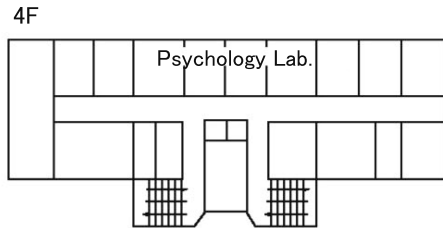
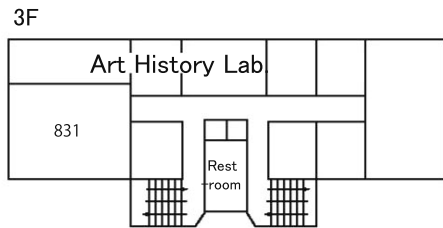
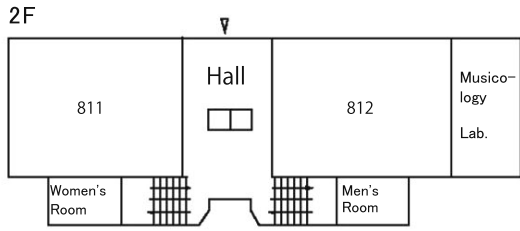
【Fourth Building Independence Wing】



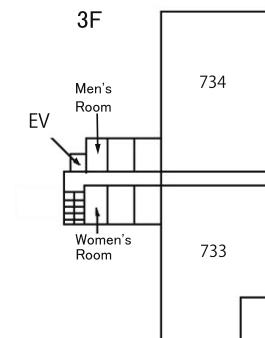
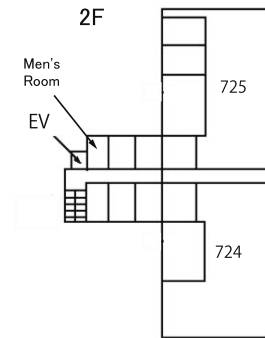
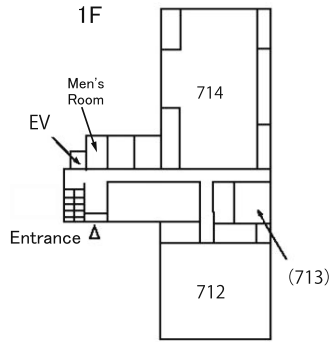
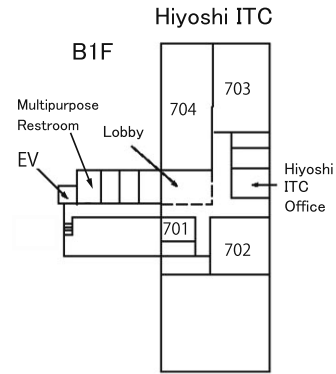
