Classroom Map

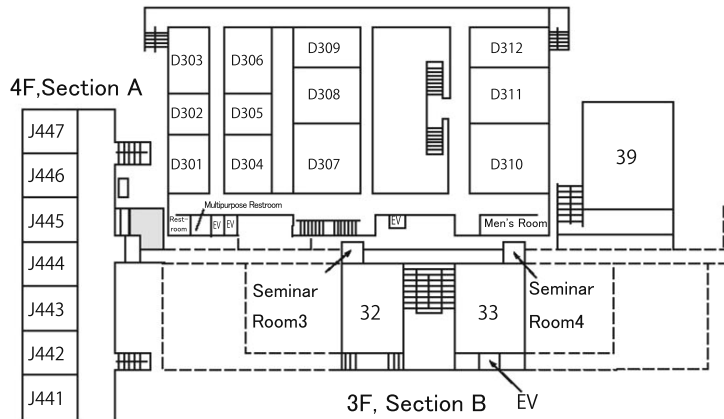
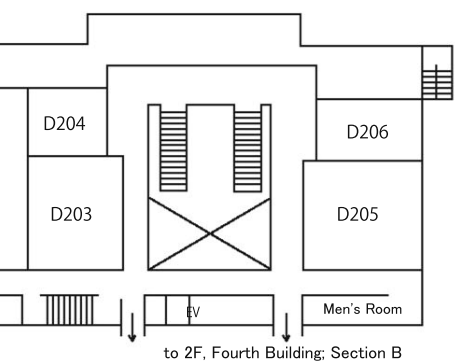
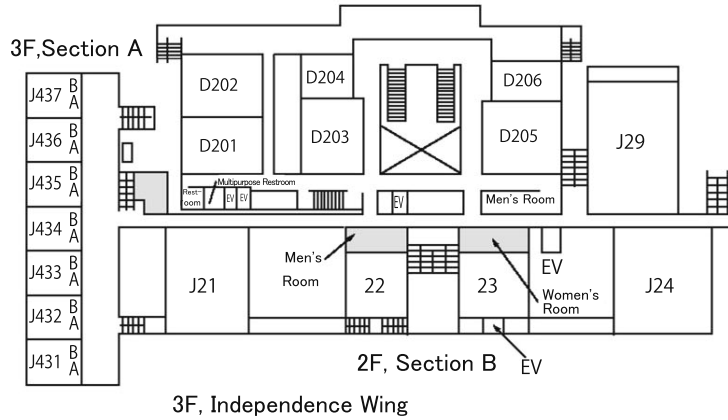
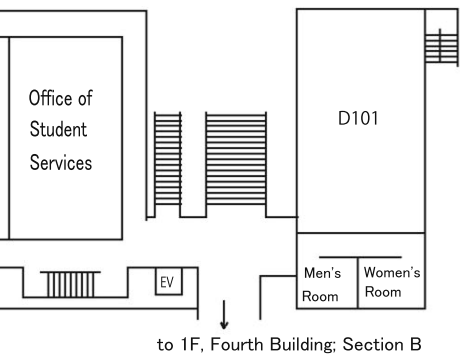
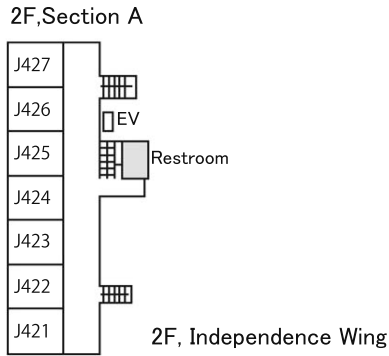
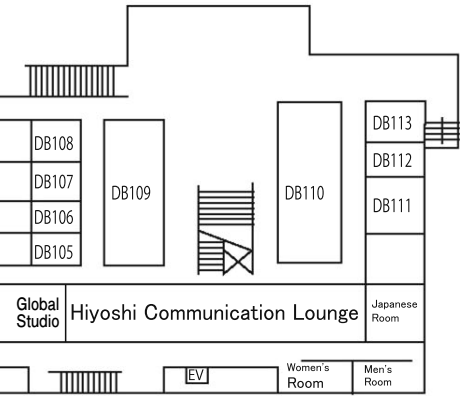
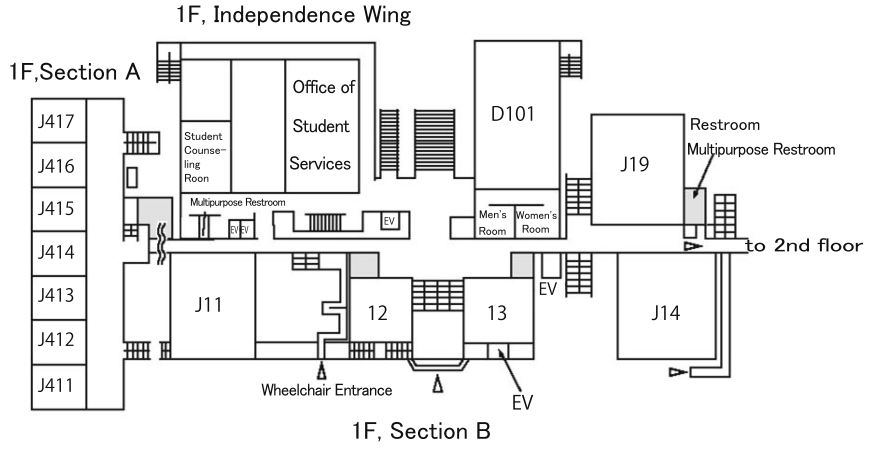
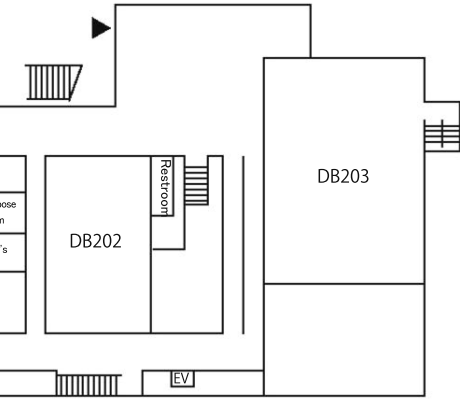
