# AY2021 Spring Semester-End Examination Make-up Examination

[Faculty of Economics, Mita Campus Affiliated Students]

Make-up examinations are open to those who are unable to take the regular examinations in Spring Semester-End Examination Period <u>from Tuesday</u>, 13 <u>July to Monday</u>, 19 <u>July</u> for an unavoidable reason. Make-up examinations are NOT conducted for classes for which an examination is not given on the regular examination period and for which evaluation is based on term papers, participation and attendance, and in class examinations.

#### Details on application are as follows:

1. Application Period

Courses at Mita Campus: <u>29 June (Tue.) - 20 July (Tue.), 11:30am</u> Courses at Hiyoshi Campus: <u>29 June (Tue.) - 26 July (Mon.), 11:30am</u> Courses at Yagami Campus: <u>29 June (Tue.) - 21 July (Wed.), 11:30am</u>

\* Interviews with an Academic Advisor on the last day of the application period can be performed until 11:00am. If your application needs to have an interview, please complete the application procedures in time for the interview.

(For students who wish to take a make-up exam for courses at Yagami Campus, please have an interview by Tuesday, 20 July.)

3. Examination Fee

#### 2,000 JPY per subject

\*Payment must be made in the form of Shoshi-stamp, which can be purchased at the Office of Student Services.

\*Examination fee will be exempted to those who apply for make-up examinations for the following reasons: delay in public transportation, and overlapping examination schedule with other campuses and Tokyo Institute of Technology.

#### <IMPORTANT NOTES>

- \*The grade for the make-up examination will be lowered by one mark. (This measure shall not apply to the cases (1) (5) mentioned in "6. Eligibility to Apply for a Make-up Examination".)
- \*Any false application will be regarded as misconduct and be subject to penalty.
- \*Make-up examination is not applicable to those who could not take the examination for his/her personal mistakes (e.g. late for exam, misunderstanding of the timetable, etc).
- \*Students are not eligible to take the make-up examination once they have taken the regular examination.
- \*Application for make-up examinations for courses held at other campuses must be made at <u>Mita</u> Office of Student Services.
- \*Also read notes on the make-up examination in the Course Registration Guide (p.21).

#### 6. Eligibility to Apply for Make-up Examination

(1) Overlapping examination schedule

If examinations are overlapping with other campuses (including Tokyo Institute of Technology), take the regular examinations for courses offered at other campuses, and apply for the make-up examinations for courses at Mita campus.

#### (2) Delay in public transport (train delays)

Applications are only accepted, in principle, on the day when the delay occurred. Applications are eligible only when students leave from the home address registered to the university, having enough time to arrive at the examination room within twenty minutes after the beginning of each period in which the examination takes place. \*Submit a certificate of delay.

- (3) Infectious diseases specified by Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology Submit a medical certificate which approves the fact that you were infected with the disease on the day of the exam. The certificate also needs to include the name of the disease and the period during which you were not permitted to attend school. \*A receipt cannot be accepted.
  - For those who have tested positive for COVID-19 (including those who (are suspected to) have close contact with a COVID-19 patient), please make an application for Special Measures.
- (4) Funerals of relatives within the second degree of kinship
  - \*Submit a copy of a letter or a document that certifies the fact.
- (5) Overlap with a national examination (for Certified Public Accountant)
  - \*Submit a copy of your admission ticket for the examination.
- (6) Other

If students wish to take make-up examinations for reasons other than above, they must have an interview with an academic advisor and obtain an approval. Remember, the grade for the make-up examination will be lowered by one mark.

- \*Submit a certificate which explain the situation . Ex. Illness (medical certificate including the content described in (3) above.), Job hunting (visit certificate from company.)
- \*An application may not be approved if the student had taken the semester-end examination for another course held on the same day.

#### <Interview with an Academic Advisor>

After applying for Spring Semester-End Make-up Examination, please confirm the academic advisor's office hour below and make an appointment. Only students applicable to have an interview will be informed how to make an appointment. Any applications after the application period will NOT be accepted, so have an interview as early as possible. There is a possibility that students who apply for reasons in (1) - (5) above will also be required to have an interview. For further details please ask Faculty of Economics Section, Office of Student Services.

\* Interviews are held on a first-come, first-served basis. Your interview schedule may not be your preferred date and time.
