Use of electronic devices such as cell phones, smartphones and smart watches during in-classroom examinations and semester-end examinations

Students are required to comply with the instructions issued by the exam proctor to switch off all electronic devices (e.g. cell phones, smart phones, and smart watches) and their alarm functions, and leave the devices in their bags before the exam commences.

Holding any of these devices, placing any of these devices on one's desk, or keeping any of these devices on one's person close at hand, will be considered academic misconduct and may be subject to strict disciplinary action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Faculty of Economics.
