<General Procedures> *All Theses

We carry out the following procedures for all the master's theses submitted to the Graduate Schools on Mita Campus:

- 1. Publicizing the Bibliographic Information
- -After being cataloged, the master's theses become searchable in our library catalog.
- -The bibliographic information of a thesis includes the author's name, thesis title, number of pages, size of volume, year of publication, type of master's degree and date of conferral.
- 2. Collecting, Storing and Providing the Master's Theses in Digital Format

The digital editions in PDF format are available on the designated computer. Note the computer is stand-alone and disconnected from the Web.

<Permission-Based Services>

The theses in which the authors have submitted the 'Permission Form for the Use of Master's Thesis' are in PDF format, and are available for printing. Note that printing is permitted for academic purposes only.

<Privacy Policy>

The personal information you provide will be used exclusively for the procedures involving your master's thesis. For more details on our privacy policy, please refer to the websites of Keio University as well as Mita Media Center.

<Copyright Laws>

The 'Permission Form for the Use of Master's Thesis' is intended to deal with the legal issues associated with copying. Although copying of published works is legal as stated in the Article 31 of the Copyright Act of Japan, the rule is not applied to master's theses that are generally considered 'unpublished.' The author's permission is required to copy unpublished works in any form regardless of the quantity. Not even a single page can be copied without permission.

Please submit your thesis in PDF/A format that is specialized for use in the archiving and long-term preservation of electronic document.
