Application to Register for Fieldwork-related Courses

Students will be allowed to register for Fieldwork-related Courses after conducting research (fieldwork) or working in a company (internship) during spring break within or outside of Japan. Both fieldwork research and internship activities should be related to individual research theme. Students who wish to register such courses must submit necessary documents during the submission period in order to obtain approval before they begin fieldwork research or internship. Students, whose fieldwork research or internship proposals could not meet the deadline or whose proposals are rejected, will not be allowed to register for any Fieldwork-related Courses.

<<Important Notes>>

Students must conduct and complete their fieldwork research and internship activities during the following period: February 2 – March 31, 2021.

Students must register one of the Fieldwork-related Courses during the spring semester 2021.

Students must submit necessary documents before they conduct fieldwork research and internship activities in order to register for Fieldwork-related Courses.

Any fieldwork research conducted during the semester cannot be registered as Fieldwork-related Courses. Such activities are to be graded as Project Courses.
