SFC Student Dormitories Application for International Students

SFC has off-campus dormitories available for international students. If you are interested in staying in one of the SFC student dormitories, read the following information carefully to apply. Please note that we cannot guarantee all of the applicants to be granted a room because the number of rooms is limited.

1. Application Eligibility

- Eligibility is limited to international students who study and expected to study from April, 2025 at Keio University and, in principle, holding a "Student" Visa.
- Students who are presently living in or applying for the JASSO dormitories or the company housing (shain-ryo) cannot apply EXCEPT students whose current lease of their aforementioned residence is about to expire.
- In principle, the current residents of the Keio dormitory and students who have lived in one of the Keio dormitories during 2024 academic year are not eligible for application.

2. Dormitories with Vacancy

We have some rooms available at the dormitories below.

- H Village Paprika House (Unit) [Both men and women (separated floors)]
- H Village Turmeric House (Unit) [Women only]
- H Village Rosemary House (Unit) [Both men and women (mixed floors)]
- H Village Basil House (Unit) [Men only]
- Shonan Fujisawa International Dormitory (1-person room) [Both men and women (separated floors)]
- Dormy Shonan Fujisawa 2 (1-person room) [Both men and women (separated floors)]

3. Housing check-in dates and times:

March 17 (Mon), 18 (Tue), 2025

*Only from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

*Date and time other than the above are not acceptable.4. The Final Date of the Period of Your Residence:

When applying, if you choose the desired period of residence as "half year", the final date of the period of your residence will be <u>August 4 (Mon), 2025</u> and for "one year", it will be <u>February 27 (Fri), 2026.</u>

- * You cannot change the "Desired period of residence" after you complete the application.
- * In accordance with the prescribed rules, if you register online one month in advance of your desired date, you may move out before the above "the final date of the period of your residence". More information will be provided in the housing orientation after you move in. (e.g. no moving out **on weekends and holidays**. One month's notice of your moving out date on "Mypage" is mandatory.)

5. Application period

From January 31 (Fri), to February 10 (Mon), 2025, 10:00 a.m. (JST)

*The deadline cannot be changed under any circumstances. Exceptions will not be made even if you have network problems.




6. Application method


Applicants for SFC Student Dormitories must register online on the website below.

(1) Click the following URL and register your email address. https://dormitory.sfc.keio.ac.jp/





- (2) Confirmation email will be sent to your registered email address.
- (3) Click the link sent to you in the confirmation email, and continue to apply. (The link is valid for 24 hours after you registered your email address.)



- (4) After filling out the application form, click Apply.
- (5) Confirmation email for your application will be sent to your registered email address. [Notes]
- * Please apply only once.
- * If you have not been informed your "Student ID Number" yet, please enter your examination number in the "Student ID/Examination Number" section of the application form.
- * If you wish to make any changes in your request after you have already sent an application, please email us at [sfc-housing@adst.keio.ac.jp] immediately, including your full name and details of the changes.
- * Please kindly understand that if your selected dormitories have no vacancy, you may be assigned to a dormitory that was not your choice.

7. Method/Schedule of notification

Application results will be sent out by email on **February 21 (Fri)**, **2025**. If you do not receive an email from SFC Student Life Section by **February 21**, please inform us immediately at [sfc-housing@adst.keio.ac.jp].

8. Notes

- When we are oversubscribed, there will be a draw. First priority will be given to freshman or students with no history of residence in one of the Keio dormitories.
- If we cannot confirm your (expected) enrollment at Keio University from April, 2024, we will void your application.

- You cannot request a particular room. All rooms will be assigned by SFC Student Life Section according to availability. You also cannot change your room once it is assigned. The room number will be informed when you move in. We will not inform a your room number in advance to move in.
- Once you cancel, you will not be able to reapply.
- If you wish to cancel your reserved accommodation, please inform us by email at [sfc-housing@adst.keio.ac.jp] as soon as possible, but no later than March 3 (Mon), 2025.
- On or after March 4 (Tue), a cancellation fee of 50,000 yen will be charged.

9. FAQ

Q1. How and when should I pay rent?

A1. In principle, the payment can be only made by manual bank transfer or automatic bank transfer (Japanese bank account only). Credit card payment is NOT accepted.

More information will be provided in the housing orientation after you move in. Please rest assured that the first payment will be <u>after you move in</u>.

The first due date for the initial rent payment including the cleaning and maintenance fee (non-refundable) will be announced AFTER your residency begins. The amount will depend on which dormitory you are allocated and which day you enter the dorm.

Q2. Is it possible to send luggage to the dormitory before I move in?

A2. No. We do not keep the luggage for you, so make sure to arrange your delivery AFTER your arrival and receive them on your own. Your room number will be announced when you check in, so it is required to write your name and the dormitory address CLEARLY. We ask residents to set the delivery time as well because we do NOT keep your package in the dormitory.

Q3. Can I change my allocated dormitory?

A3. No. Your allocated room cannot be changed to any other dormitories. Please understand that not every applicant has been accepted according to one's preferences. Some applicants have not even been assigned to any of the dormitories.

(2) Announcement of dormitory assignment (On February 21 (Fri), 2025)

SFC Student Life Section will inform all the applicants by email whether their applications are approved on February 21 (Fri), 2025. If you want to cancel your reserved accommodation, please inform us by email at [sfc-housing@adst.keio.ac.jp] by March 3 (Mon), 2025.

On or after March 4 (Tue), 2025, a cancellation fee of 50,000 yen will be charged



(3) Registering your arrival details (Registration Deadline: March 4 (Tue), 2025)

If your dormitory application is accepted, you will be informed the link to access the "My Page" of the SFC dormitory system. You must register your arrival details through "My page" by March 4 (Tue), 2025.

Check-in hours: Only from 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. (18:00)
