Applications for the AY 2019 Keio Graduate School Scholarship are now open. Please read below on how to apply.

1. Scholarship Amount:

- Graduate School of Letters, Economics, Law, Human Relations, Business and Commerce, Science and Technology, Pharmaceutical Science 500,000 yen per year
- Graduate School of Media and Governance, Health Management Master's Program: 600,000 yen per year Doctoral Program: 500,000 yen per year
- Graduate School of Medicine, Business Administration, System Design and Management, Media Design 600,000 yen per year

2. Scholarship Duration:

1 year from April (Recipients may re-apply in the following academic year)

3. Eligible Applicants:

- Master's and doctoral students (entering in April, excluding students of the Law School)
- Students with Japanese nationality and students of other nationalities whose status is "Permanent resident", "Special permanent resident", "Long-term resident" or "Dependent"
- * There will be a separate recruitment in the Fall Semester for privately financed international students whose status of residence is "Student."

4. Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must meet all the following criteria:

- Applicants must be motivated researchers and deemed to be experiencing financial hardship.
- Applicants must demonstrate both academic excellence and outstanding character and be in good health.
- Applicants for whom the scholarship period does not exceed the standard term of study (2 years for master's students and 3 years for doctoral students)
- * Students who have repeated the previous year may also apply, but this factor will be taken into consideration during the selection process.
- Applicants must not have any outstanding tuition payments up to the Fall Semester 2017 academic year at the time of application.
