< 応募上の注意 >

- ◆ 面接は主として英語で行います。
  - ◆ 3校まで志望校を併願できます。
  - ◆ 国際センター枠あるいは経済学部・経済学研究科枠のどちらかに応募した学生は、その結果が判明するまで、もう一方の募集枠による交換留学に応募することはできません。また合格した場合、他の募集枠に応募することはできず、合格を辞退することもできません。(国際センター枠第2期に応募はできません。)
  - ◆ 派遣交換留学で留学する学生は、出発から帰国までの本学指定の海外旅行保険への加入ならびに危機管理支援サービスへの登録が義務付けられています(約15万円)。
  - ◆ II期に応募して留学する場合は、出発日より慶應義塾で履修した秋学期科目(セット科目の場合は春学期科目を含む)が無効となる可能性がありますので注意して下さい。
  - ◆ 経済学部・経済学研究科枠の第I期において不合格となった場合でも、同一派遣先の第II期(追加募集)に応募することができます。
  - ◆ 学部4年に在学する学生が応募し、在学期間延長中に留学することは可能です。ただし、在学期間延長制度を用いて学部4年に在籍している場合、応募はできません。
  - ◆ 経済学部・経済学研究科による交換留学制度による交換留学生は、国際センターが募集する日本学生支援機構(JASSO)短期留学奨学金および慶應義塾大交換留学生(派遣)奨学金に応募することはできません。
  - ◆ カリフォルニア大学の半期留学の期間は、カリフォルニア大学の1term/semesterです。

- ◆ Interviews are conducted mainly in English
  - ◆ Students may apply to programmes of up to three different hosting universities
  - ◆ Students who have applied to the programmes offered by the International Center are not allowed to submit applications for those offered by the Faculty of Economics and the Graduate School of Economics until the result of the selection for the International Center program is announced and vice versa. In addition, students are not allowed to withdraw from the program offered by the International Center to submit applications for those offered by the Faculty of Economics and the Graduate School of Economics and vice versa. (In this case, they are not allowed to apply to the programmes offered by the International Center during the Application Period II.)
  - ◆ Students who study abroad under the student exchange programmes are obliged to purchase overseas travel insurance specified by Keio University, which covers from departure to return and to be registered with the crisis management support service (between 150,000 – 200,000 yen).
  - ◆ Please note that study abroad program offered in second-round application period may start before the end of fall semester, which may result in invalidation of the registration of entire fall semester courses and spring-fall "set" courses.
  - ◆ Even in the case that applicants, who applied to the programme by the Faculty of Economics and the Graduate School of Economics, were not successful in the first-round application, they may re-apply to the programme of the same hosting university during the second-round application period.
  - ◆ Fourth year students of Faculty of Economics may apply in their fourth year and go on to study abroad during the period of extension of enrolment, provided that they apply for the extension. Those who are already enrolled in their extended period of enrolment at Faculty of Economics are not eligible to apply.
  - ◆ Students under the student exchange program offered by the Faculty of Economics and/or the Graduate School of Economics are not eligible to apply to JASSO Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Short-term Study Abroad) and Keio University Scholarship for Exchange Students (Out Going) offered by International Center.
  - ◆ Those students who are selected to the University of California program to study for a half a year, they can take classes for one term/semester only. The period of one term/semester is specified by the University of California.
  - ◆ Please note that programs at UC EAP and HEC starts before the end of the fall semester, which results in invalidation of the registration of entire fall semester courses and spring-fall "set" courses.
