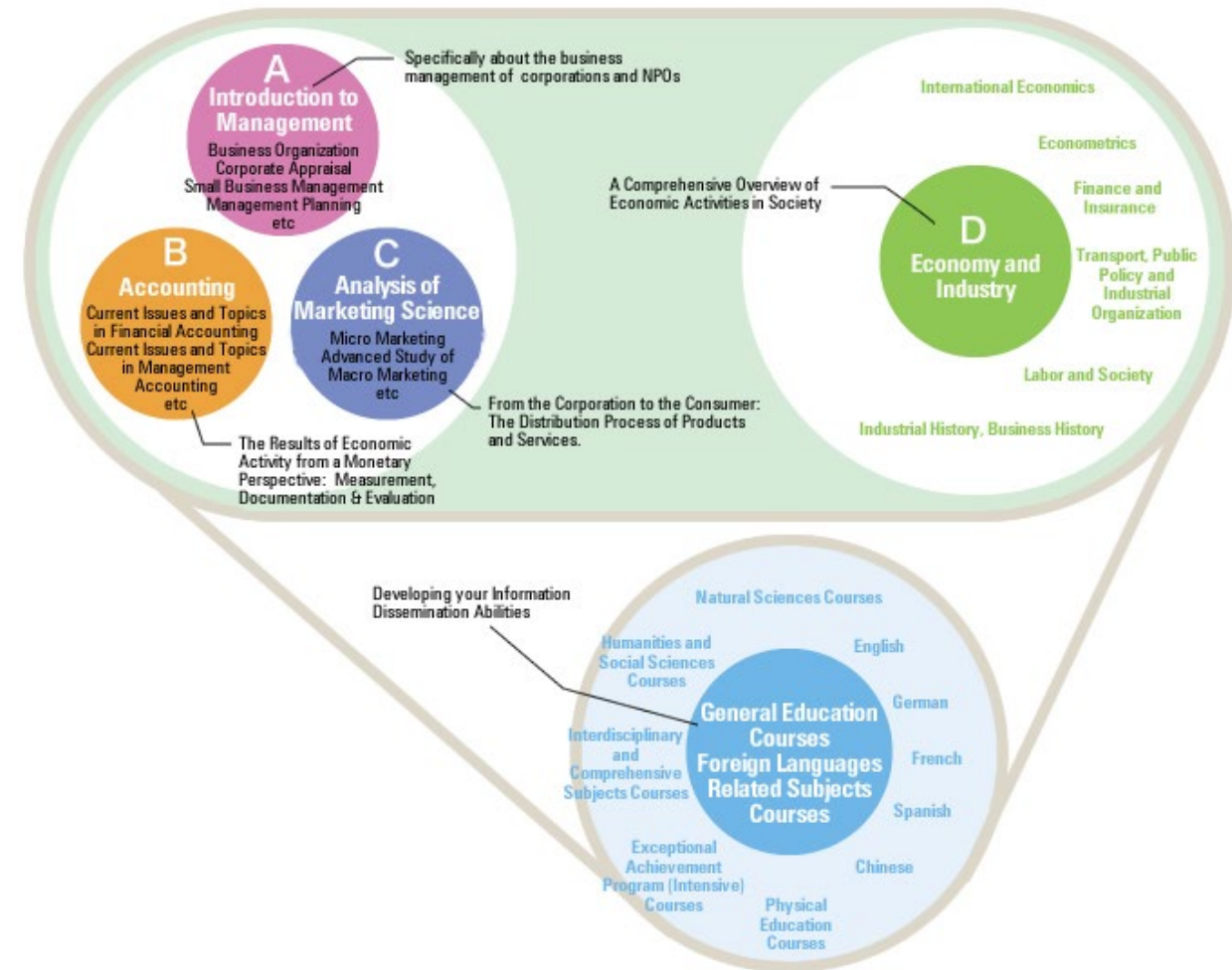



- To graduate Keio FBC, you need **128 Keio credits**.
- You have already earned **64 Keio credits**, transferred from ESSEC.
- So you need to earn **64 Keio credits** during S5-S8.

- **Internship** and **bachelor thesis** are compulsory.
 - You will earn **8 Keio credits** for your **internship** in S7.
 - You will earn 30 ECTS, including **bachelor thesis**, in S8.  The rules on the **ESSEC** side
 ⇒ These 30 ECTS will be transferred as **16 Keio credits** (including **4 credits** for **bachelor thesis**).

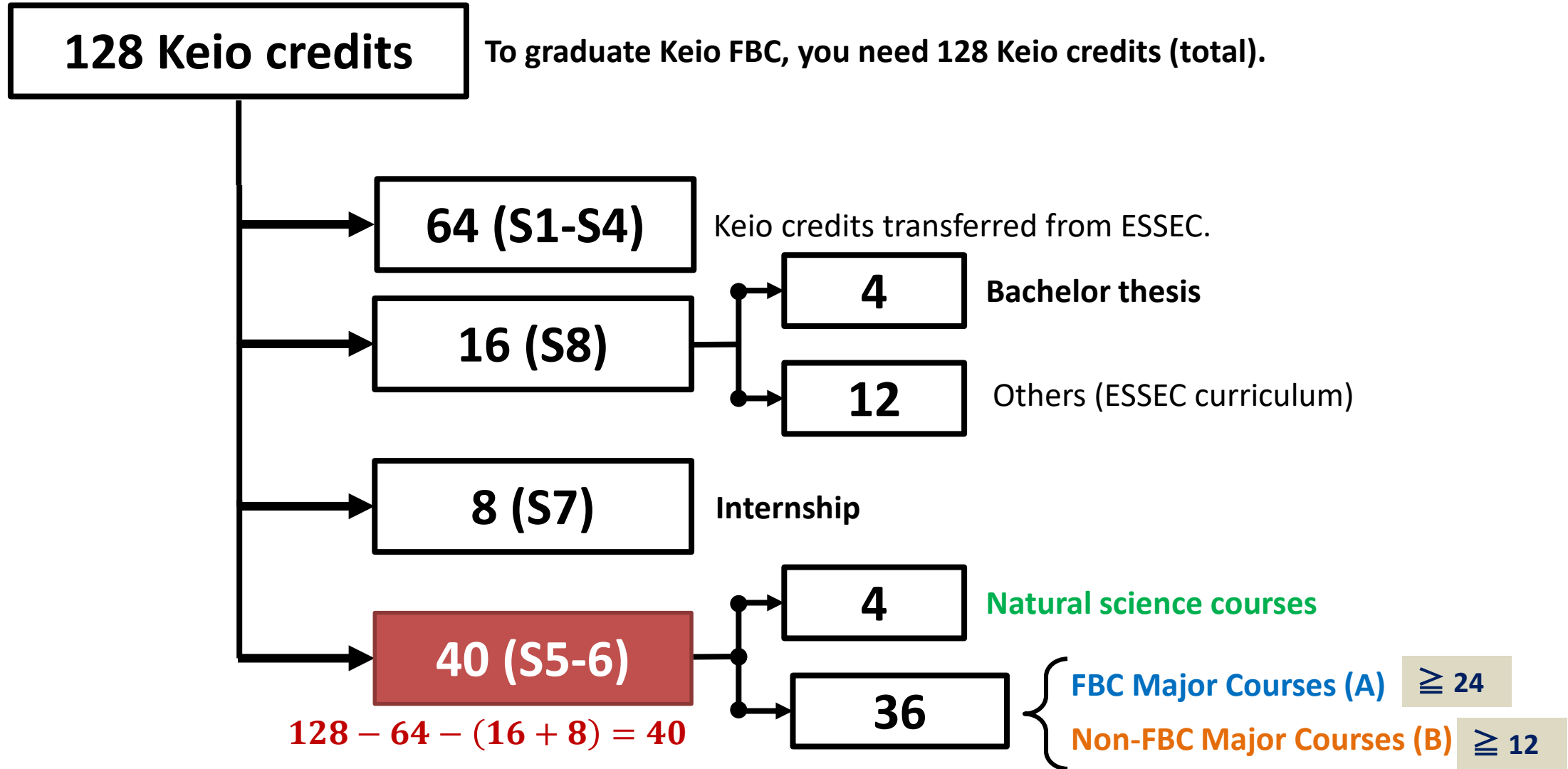

$$64 - (8 + 16) = 40$$

- You must earn remaining **40 Keio credits** during **S5-S6**.
- There are three course categories from which you must choose:
 - **Natural science courses**
 - **FBC Major Courses**
 - **Non-FBC Major Courses (including Business-Related Subjects at FBC)**

Key points during S5-S6



* $A \geq 24$ and $B \geq 12$ are general rules meant to facilitate the fulfillment of your graduation requirements. If you are unable to satisfy these conditions in S5-6, please make sure that the graduation requirements ($A = 36$ and $B = 28$) are met at the completion of S7-8. You may consult the advising faculty member at Keio FBC if you have any concerns about meeting the graduation requirements.

- To graduate Keio FBC, you **must** earn...

- 128 Keio credits (total).
- 4 Keio credits of **natural science courses**
- 36 Keio credits of **FBC Major Courses**
- 28 Keio credits of **Non-FBC Major Courses**

- during total semesters (S1-S8) in ESSEC & Keio curriculums.

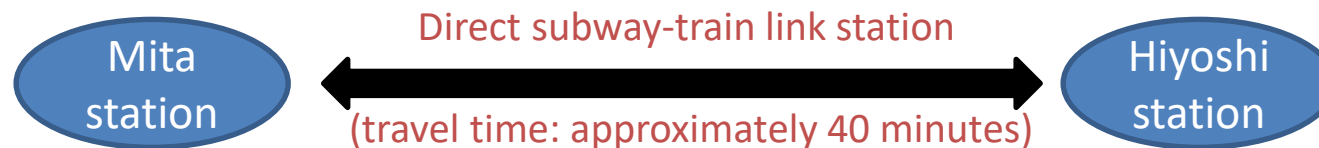

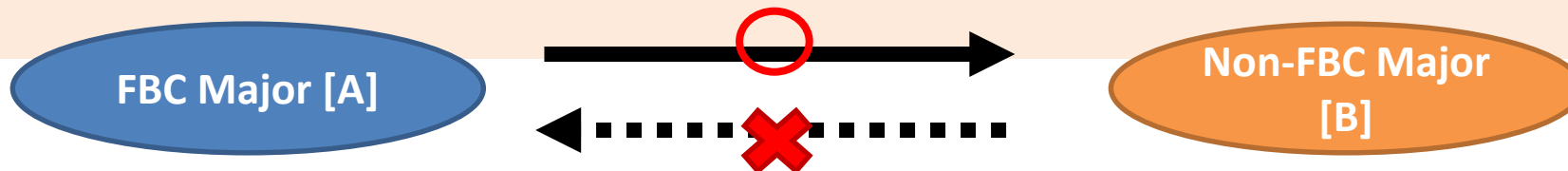

- Credits on **FBC Major Courses** can convert into those on **Non-FBC Major Courses**.
- Students are recommended to proactively earn Keio credits on **FBC Major Courses**



Notes & Exceptions

- You can convert registration of **FBC Major Courses[A]** into those of **Non-FBC Major Courses [B]**.
=> We suggest that you get a lot of credits of **FBC Major Courses [A]** credits first.
- You cannot register for more than 50 credits worth of FBC Major and Non-FBC Major Courses in S5 and S6.
- If you fail to earn **4 Keio credits of natural science courses** during S5-S6
 - * Take “Sustainable development”/ “Product innovation” at ESSEC in S8.
Note: There is no guarantee that these two courses are offered at ESSEC in S8.
- If you fail to earn **40 Keio credits** in S5-S6 due to extenuating circumstances...
 - * Take more than 30 ECTS at ESSEC in S8.
Note: The conversion rate for extra ECTS is 2 ECTS = 1 Keio credit.
There is a limit to the number of transferrable credits.

Japanese Language Courses

Courses offered by Center for Japanese Studies

- Up to 2 courses per semester.
- **Non credit-bearing.**
- Keio FBC will cover the course fee (20,000 Yen per course).
- Must pay for the materials on your own.
- Must sign-up online **prior** to a semester.
- Must attend the first class for instructor approval.
