Sep. 29 (Fri.) 6:00 p.m. (JST) – Oct. 9 (Mon.) 10:00 a.m. (JST)	<p><u>Second Course Registration Period</u></p> <p>If students wish to add or delete courses as a result of the First Course Registration, please do so on the “Course Registration” screen via keio.jp during the Second Course Registration Period. The courses which appear as “Lottery planned”, “Registration-accepted students to be finalized”, “[Registration Restriction] Not planned” are the only courses which can be added. Lottery would be held 2 times as below, and 3rd lottery would also be held after the Second Course Registration Period.</p> <p>1st lottery: Oct. 3 (Tue.) 5:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. 2nd lottery: Oct. 5 (Thu.) 5:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.</p> <p>The 1st and 2nd lottery would be held for courses which exceed the maximum number of students by 5:00 p.m. each day. Please make sure to confirm the result on 6:30 p.m. on keio.jp.</p> <p>As a result of the lottery, courses which are permitted will be displayed as “Registration-accepted students finalized (Registration accepted).” and courses which are not permitted will be displayed as “Registration not accepted”. Courses that lottery was not made will be displayed as “Lottery planned”. In this case, the students are not permitted to register the courses yet.</p> <p>After the end of Second Course Registration Period, a lottery will be held for courses which exceed the maximum number of students. Please make sure to confirm the results of the lottery displayed on the “Confirmation of Registered Courses” screen, on Oct. 10 (Tue.) 12:00 a.m. The students cannot add any more courses after the Second Course Registration Period regardless of the lottery results.</p>
