

## Application Guidelines for Keio Student Dormitories near Shonan Fujisawa Campus (SFC)

Keio University is expanding its student dormitories to provide more active support to students from outside of the Kanto area and from overseas in terms of enrollment and support for students living in the dormitories. Therefore, students with no prior working experience will be given priority to enter the dormitory. There are two student dormitories for Keio students near SFC. If you are interested in entering a dormitory, please apply in line with the instructions below. Please note that, due to the limited number of rooms available, we cannot guarantee that all applicants will be able to move into the dormitory of their choice.

### 1. Application Eligibility:

Students who are currently enrolled at Keio University or who have made a decision to enter Keio University.

### 2. Application Period:

\* The application deadline will not be changed even if there is a delay in data transmission due to network problems or other reasons, or if data transmission cannot be completed on time due to temporary network congestion.

If there are vacancies, applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, and will be closed once its quota has been reached.

(\*2) When the contract has ended, costs associated with restoring the room to its original condition (for Shonan Fujisawa International Dormitory, a room cleaning fee of 35,000 JPY is required) will be charged from the deposit, with the remainder to be refunded. Additional fees will be charged for any stains, damage, or loss to the room or fixtures other than those sustained in the course of normal use.

(\*3) Breakfast and dinner will be provided for dormitory students from Monday through Sunday. (excluding during year-end and new-year's holidays and August summer holidays (*Obon*))

(\*4) Breakfast and dinner will be provided for dormitory students from Monday through Friday. (excluding during national holidays, during year-end and new-year's holidays, and August summer holidays (*Obon*))

### 4. Dormitory move-in date and time:

**The move-in period for the student dormitories near SFC is scheduled on March 30 and March 31 2025.**

- \* Details will be provided to those whose allocations are confirmed as soon as they are finalized.
- \* Check-in times: From 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- \* Students will not be allowed to move into the dormitory outside of the set period.
- \* If you arrive after your designated time, you may not be able to move in on the day.

### 5. Deadline for moving-out of the dormitory:

When applying for a dormitory, you may select **"1 year, 2 years, 3 years, or 4 years"** in the "Desired period of residence" section.

- \* The deadline date for moving-out of the dormitory for each year is March 24.
- \* Cancellation of contract midway through its term:
  - Please submit the "Notice of Moving Out of Dormitory" at least 2 months prior to your moving-out date to move out of the dormitory.
  - There will be no refunds of the annual management fee, etc. that have been paid.
- \* **It is possible to renew the contract period.** When renewing your contract, you are required to pay the annual management fee and, in the case of the Shonan Fujisawa International Dormitory, an amount equivalent to the dormitory move-in fee based on the number of years you have lived in the dormitory.

6. **How to apply:** Please apply online at the following URL.

- (2) A confirmation email will be sent to your registered email address.

\* We recommend that students use their personal email address if possible.

- (3) Please click on the URL in the confirmation email to continue with the application process. (The URL is valid for 24 hours after the email address is registered.)

Please note that it may be difficult to meet all requests due to the number of rooms, operational policies, etc.

- (4) After filling out the application form, click **Apply**.

- (5) A confirmation email will be sent to your registered email address after application.

[Other precautions when applying]

- \* You may apply only once per person per semester.
- \* If you do not know your student ID number at the time of application, please enter your examination number in the "Student ID/Examination Number" section of the application form.
- \* If there are any changes to your application once you have applied, please send an email to [sfc-housing@adst.keio.ac.jp] with your full name and the details of the change.
- \* Please note that if the dormitory of your choice is already full, you will be assigned to another dormitory.

\* All applicants will be notified of the housing allocation results by email on the above-mentioned announcement date to the email address registered at the time of application. If you do not receive an email during the day of the announcement, please contact the Student Life Section [sfc-housing@adst.keio.ac.jp] from the following day onward.

**8. Procedures after the announcement:**

Prospective students who have been allocated a dormitory will be contacted individually by Nishimatsu-Jisho Co., Ltd., regarding contract procedures, so please follow their instructions.

\* Upon confirmation of the following information, we will send out a set of contract documents. International shipping is possible.

- Period of Contract
- Date of moving-in
- Guarantor (indicate the person with the highest income as the guarantor)

☆ Please note that changes cannot be accepted after the contract documents have been sent.

\* Documents to be prepared beforehand

The following documents must be enclosed when returning the contract documents.

- Certificates of Residence of the guarantor and dormitory resident (only one copy is needed if residing in the same household)
- Seal Registration Certificate of the guarantor

If you reside overseas and are unable to submit a Certificate of Residence and Seal Registration Certificate, please prepare the following documents.

(Certificate of Residence) can be substituted by a Residency Certificate

(Seal Registration Certificate) can be substituted by a Signature Certificate

\* The above can be obtained at the Embassy or Consulate.

**9. Other precautions:**

- Students belonging to the Shonan Fujisawa Campus may also apply for student dormitories near the Hiyoshi and Mita Campuses, but they cannot apply together with the student dormitories near Shonan Fujisawa Campus (SFC).
- If there are many applicants, a lottery will be held.

- In the unlikely event that you are not selected in the lottery, you will receive information about recommended student dormitories directly from the management company only if you check the box on the application form "I agree to share my application details with the university's affiliated student dormitory management company and to receive recommendations directly from the management company" when applying.
- Those wishing to tour H Village and Shonan Fujisawa International Dormitory must contact the following management companies directly and make an appointment to visit the dormitory in advance.

- Room assignments are made by the Office of Student Services (Student Life), therefore we cannot guarantee your room location preferences. In addition, the assigned dormitory/room type cannot be changed. Your room number will be provided on-site on the day you move in. It is not possible to inform you of your room number prior to moving into the dormitory.
- If you wish to cancel your application for dormitory housing, please contact the SFC Student Life Section [sfc-housing@adst.keio.ac.jp] at least [3 business days before the result announcement date].
- **You cannot apply again once you have canceled your application.**
- Cancellation after allocation is confirmed:
  - < H Village > Cancellation after signing a contract with the management company will incur a penalty fee. Therefore, once the initial fees have been paid, the annual management fees that have already been paid will not be refunded. A penalty of JPY 200,000 will be charged for cancellation after the signing of the contract and prior to payment of the fees.
  - < Shonan Fujisawa International Dormitory > Cancellation after signing a contract with the management company will incur a penalty fee. Therefore, once the initial fees have been paid, the dormitory move-in fee and annual management fees that have already been paid will not be refunded. A penalty of JPY 200,000 will be charged for cancellation after the signing of the contract and prior to payment of the fees.

## 10. Other notes:

### H Village Scholarship (for undergraduate students)
