〈過去の不正行為とその処分例〉

- 一． レポートにおいて剽窃を行ったため、当該学期、全科目の単位取得を認めない。
- 二． 履修者以外の学生が、履修者本人になりすまして定期試験を受験したため、いずれの学生も当該学期、全科目の単位取得を認めず、かつ、一ヶ月の停学処分。

Students who have committed acts of academic misconduct in reports, assignments, examinations, etc., will be severely punished, and may be assigned a failing grade of D for all courses they registered for the semester in question.

Additionally, they may also face suspension or expulsion.

<Past examples of academic misconduct and the resulting disciplinary action>

1. A student was found to have committed plagiarism, and was consequently not awarded any credit for courses taken during the semester in question.
2. A student who was not registered for a course impersonated and took the semester-end examination on the behalf of a registered student. As a consequence, both students were not awarded any credit for courses taken during the semester in question and suspended for one month.

We strongly urge all students to undertake their studies with honesty and integrity, and to refrain from any behavior that could be construed as acts of academic misconduct.
