Eligibility Criteria	<p>This scholarship is open to students who</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> possessing superior academic achievements and excellent character; recognized as having the potential to work as researchers in the future; are of good health <p>*If the scholarship recipient takes a temporary leave of absence, or becomes subject to disciplinary action, such as suspension or expulsion during the academic year, they will lose their eligibility to receive the scholarship and may be asked to return the scholarship funds.</p> <p>*Privately financed international students must have completed the Scholarship Applicant Registration for Fall Semester 2023 academic year. https://www.ic.keio.ac.jp/en/life/scholarship/application.html</p>
Combination with Other Scholarships	<p>There is no limit to the number of scholarships that can be combined with the Koizumi Memorial Graduate School Special Scholarship, however, there are cases in which other scholarships (Japanese Government Scholarships, etc.) do not allow you to combine your scholarships. It is your responsibility to check with your scholarship provider (source of funding) to see if you are able to receive both scholarships.</p> <p>*Students in receipt of, or set to receive, other scholarships, including the Research Fellowship for Young Scientists from the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science, and Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST) can also apply. However, this may be taken into consideration during the selection process.</p>
